LREDC HSEQ Regulations:

- It is mandatory to mention the Nightshift In-charge Contact to support and attend any damage/ leakage to their de-watering system.
- Contractors/developers should obtain HSEQ approval prior to their night work.
- Contractors/developers should inform any issues related to their access to site or any change in traffic pattern.
- Site boundaries/fence and gates should have sufficient lighting to be visible for vehicles and constructions traffic moving around.
- Approach roads for construction sites should have sufficient lighting arrangement for safe driving.
- Contractor/developers to ensure all the vehicles in use have headlights and tail lights in proper working condition.
- All construction traffic including buses should have reflecting triangle pasted on the back side of vehicle.
- Contractors/developers to pass on stringent instructions to their logistics supervisors to have special monitoring on over speeding
- Larger vehicular volume is experienced carrying earth fill material, special attention is required not to fill dumpers over the limit in addition to have covering to the dumpers.
- Construction nearby residential areas shall be careful not exceeding vibration and noise producing limits set by MOE.
- Adequate firefighting equipment
- Adequate lighting in all areas and not restricted to operational areas
- Crane in use must have all relevant testing inspection and certification, lifting plan in place and all necessary controls in place for safe lifting operation.
- Full time safety supervision
- Evidence of safety inspection reports for the related operation.
- All necessary safe system of work established e.g. edge protection, safe working at height etc.
- Bank person in place to supervise vehicle movement including reversing
- Working vehicles must have flashing beacons and it must be operated in all times
- PPE is mandatory

NOTES

- The form should be filled by the Main Contractor or Consultant on behalf of the Developer Package
- It is mandatory for Contractor to attend Safety Induction by authorized signatory at HSEQ Department, LREDC to complete the approval process.
- Form to be enclosed with Safety Inspection Reports.
- Form to be enclosed with Safety Induction & relevant training records.
- Form to be enclosed with crane certificates, lifting plan & operator certificate
